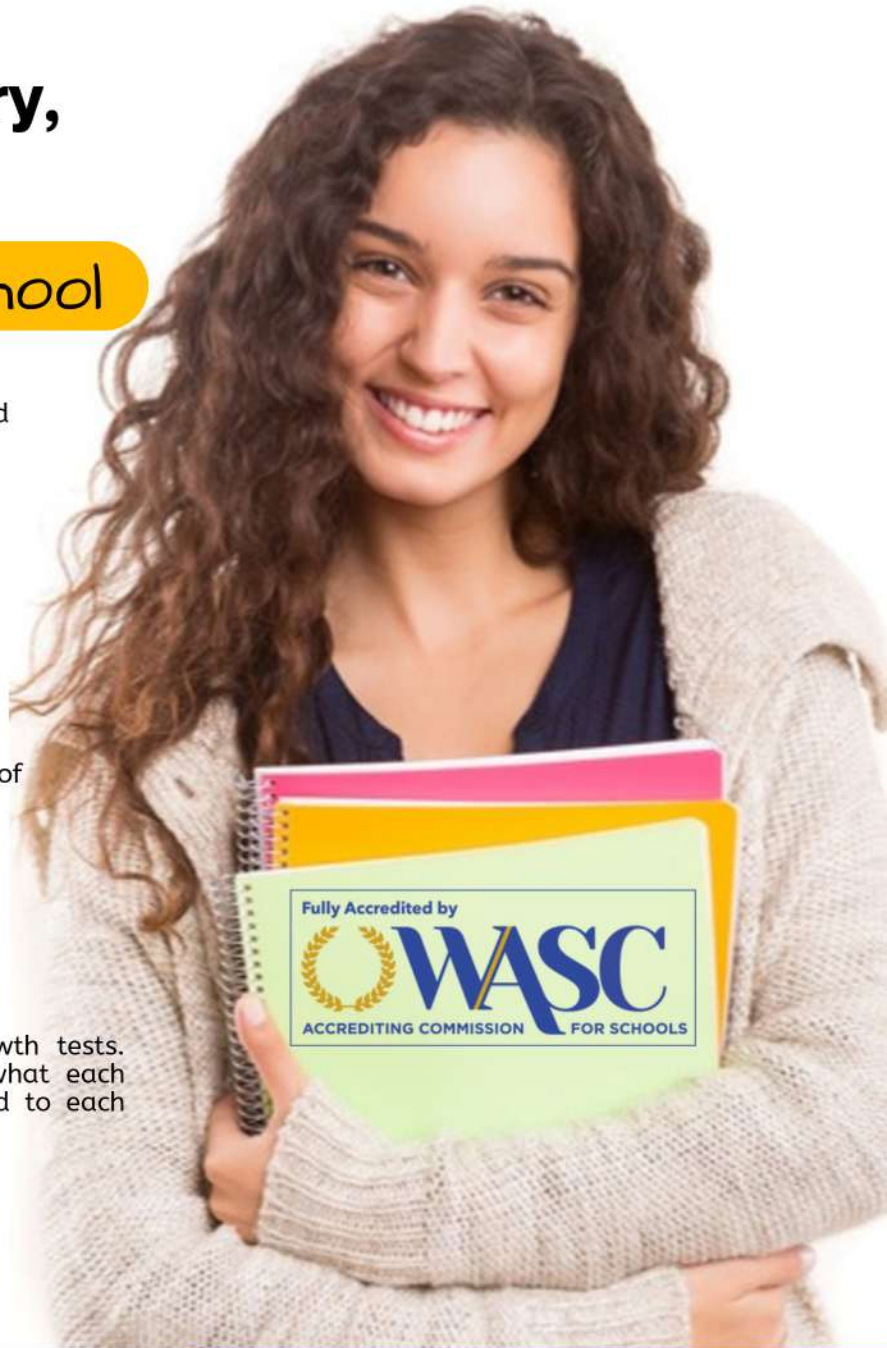
Why Woodbridge Academy?

Woodbridge Academy uses NWEA's MAP Growth tests. This system allows us to diagnose exactly what each student knows to create a curriculum tailored to each student's individual needs.

Our pedagogical approach

After enrolling, each student receives access to their Canvas LMS virtual classroom via their registered email address, where the course content is distributed.

Most courses are divided into four 8-week units, for 32 weeks per year. All student services, access, manuals, and tutoring can be found on our website: www.woodbridge.gt

Each week, a project or integrated lesson is presented based on the main subjects according to the NGSS (Next Generation Science Standards) and/or California Common Core Standards.

Students have an optional weekly group video conference to answer questions with their teachers. These conferences are recorded, so those who did not attend can view them later.

Tutoring is provided through a chat system or email integrated into the platform or by appointment. Our AI tutor, Barbara, is available 24/7 and can help with all subjects at any level. You can create a free account at: isea.ws/barbara

Inside the virtual classroom, students can access interactive curriculum content provided by companies such as Education.com®, Study.com, NWEA, and BrainPOP®, among others, at no additional cost.

We do not have synchronized classes, meaning each student connects at the most convenient time. There is no tutoring on weekends unless you use Barbara.

Enrollment is paid only by first-time students. Annual tuition is due 60 days after registration.

How to enroll?

1. Read and agree to the Terms and Conditions: isea.ws/terms
2. First time with us? Pay the Enrollment fee at: isea.ws/pay
3. Fill out the Enrollment Application and upload the required PDF documents here: isea.ws/enroll
4. Schedule your first Zoom call with your tutor at isea.ws/whs

You will receive a link to pay the annual tuition 30 days after enrollment. This payment is due 30 days upon receipt.

24 to 72 hours after you complete the enrollment application, you will receive our welcome kit with login credentials and all the information you need to keep in touch with your tutors.

On your first Zoom call with your tutor or the headmaster, you and your child will be walked through the Canvas LMS platform, your courses will be assigned, and your first MapGrowth test will be scheduled.

The MapGrowth test should be taken during the first month after enrollment. Based on the test results, another meeting will be scheduled to discuss areas for improvement and the creation of your PSP (Personal Study Plan)

The MapGrowth test is not used to grade students.
